# If you wish to appeal your grade

## Deciding to make an appeal

If you are close to a grade boundary you may decide you want to make an appeal to the examination board for a remark. If you want to do this you should talk to your class teacher who can offer advice as appeals are expensive.

Sandwell Academy will pay for the appeal if you are within two marks of a grade boundary. If you are further away from this you will be expected to pay.

You should also appeal one unit at a time as your marks can go either up or down.
